


project objectives:

seniors


the concept of ONLINE TRAINING

advantages of online education for the elderly care centers:

- it is usually **free of charge** or very affordable;
- available at any geographical location;
 - > you don't have to find local experts to train your staff or send people anywhere for the in-person training
- it is especially good for training volunteers in your organization;
- it is easier to fit in a busy schedule.

Online education is a good way to train staff with very little resources.

number of online based courses at the UT:




Figure 1 . Increase in the number of e-courses at the University of Tartu 2010-2018
